

ALL Roof Revive Installation Guide

1. Roof Inspection & Preparation

- Inspect the existing roof to ensure the substrate is structurally sound and suitable for refurbishment.
- Ensure the surface is clean, dry, and free from loose debris or contaminants.
- Repair damaged or unstable areas before application.
- Clear all outlets and drainage points.

2. Surface Cleaning

- Clean the roof thoroughly using a pressure washer or approved cleaning method.
- Remove dirt, moss, algae, loose coatings, and surface contamination.
- Allow the roof to fully dry before priming.

3. Primer Application

- Apply Revive Primer evenly across the prepared roof surface using a roller or brush.
- Ensure full and consistent coverage.
- Allow primer to fully dry prior to applying ALL Roof Revive.

4. ALL Roof Revive Application

- Stir ALL Roof Revive thoroughly before use.
- Apply evenly using a brush or roller to form a seamless waterproof membrane.
- Work in manageable sections to maintain consistent coverage.
- Pay close attention to joints, details, penetrations, and roof edges.

5. Waterproofing Performance

- The liquid rubber-based formulation instantly waterproofs the roof surface upon application.
- The flexible membrane accommodates normal roof movement and weather exposure.

6. Curing

- Allow the coating to fully cure before permitting foot traffic or additional works.
- Cure times will vary depending on temperature and weather conditions.

7. Completed System

- Once cured, the system forms a durable, seamless, and weather-resistant waterproof membrane.
- The coating restores roof performance and extends service life without full roof replacement.

Avoid application in extremely low temperatures or excessive direct heat.

Always follow recommended coverage rates.

Use appropriate PPE during installation.
