

## GRP ROOF REVIVE INSTALLATION GUIDE

### 1. Roof Inspection & Preparation

- Inspect the existing GRP roof to ensure the substrate is structurally sound and suitable for refurbishment.
- Ensure the roof surface is clean, dry, and free from debris.
- Remove dirt, moss, loose coatings, and contaminants.
- Repair any damaged areas prior to coating application.
- Ensure outlets and drainage points are clear.

### 2. Cleaning The Roof Surface

- Thoroughly clean the roof using a pressure washer or suitable cleaning solution.
- Allow the roof surface to fully dry before applying primer.

### 3. Primer Application

- Apply Revive Primer evenly across the prepared GRP surface using a roller or brush.
- Ensure consistent coverage across the entire roof.
- Avoid excessive build-up or ponding.
- Allow primer to dry fully before coating application.

### 4. GRP Roof Revive Application

- Stir GRP Roof Revive thoroughly prior to use.
- Apply evenly using a brush or roller.
- Work in manageable sections for consistent coverage.
- Pay close attention to joints, edges, and detailing.
- Ensure an even thickness throughout the roof surface.

### 5. Curing

- Allow the coating to fully cure before permitting foot traffic (refer to product SDS for more information).
- Cure times may vary depending on temperature and weather conditions.

### 6. Completed System

- Once cured, the system coating restores appearance, improves waterproofing, and extends roof lifespan.
- GRP Roof Revive can be re-applied multiple times with no primer needed.

#### Important Notes

Do not apply during wet weather or when rain is imminent.

Avoid application in extremely low temperatures or excessive direct heat.

Always follow recommended coverage rates.

Use suitable PPE during installation.
